FREE JUMPING

Run over one or two days (depending on entries), the Free Jumping classes will be judged on the following criteria, with a score out of ten for each and recording of the height that was jumped clear at the last fence.

- Bascule
- Technique
- Scope & Carefulness
- Agility

Free jumping will be in a conventional jumping lane (on the left rein). The jumping lane will consist of three elements in the order below:

- a cross pole fence (0.5m high)
- an upright (0.7m high)
- a parallel oxer (1m wide x 1m high)

The first two fences will comprise normal show jumping rails; the third fence may include some infill. The set distance of 7.5m between the obstacles will suit most horses without alteration. Adjustments of no more than 0.5m each way may be made for long or short striding horses.
